



Colorado Coalition for the Homeless Community Resources

The Community Resources program was created to assist our single, homeless clients in accessing the resources needed to end their homelessness. The program is located at the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless 2111 Champa St Denver, CO 80205. It is often times the initial step in accessing other CCH programs and resources in the community. Community Resources is designed to help people meet their short-term needs and to transition clients, with more intensive needs, into other services. The specific services provided by this department include, but are not limited to the following:

- Permanent housing
- Short-term case management
- Referrals to other agencies
- Payeeships
- Bus Tokens
- Benefit Applications
- Advocacy

Community Resources provides services to clients during scheduled walk-in times. Each walk-in period allows for Community Resources to see 25 clients. The walk-in sign-up times are as follows:

Monday-Friday at 8:30

Each walk-in time is done by lottery so the order in which people are signed up is not the order in which they will be seen. Everyone needing to be seen will have the opportunity to sign up for the walk-in lottery.
