Mental Health	The Stout Street Clinic Mental Health team provides psychiatric assessments, clinical case management services, medication treatment and group therapy for homeless adults. New patients are accepted by internal referral only on a space available basis. Individuals who have been in treatment within the past three years but haven't been seen in the past twelve months may self-refer for a new assessment to resume care. Triage line: 303-293-6512.
