Suggested ways to engage your workforce in solutions to end homelessness:

At your location, host a team activity to pack personal hygiene kits to be distributed through Coalition Outreach activities. A donation of \$2,500 will cover the cost of materials needed. A Coalition representative can be available to meet your group and provide a brief (15 min.) presentation about the Coalition's work and the importance of the team activity.

Host a summer cookout or seasonal celebration for individuals and families who live in a Coalition residence. Volunteers bring foods and activities, cook and clean-up, and interact with residents. Activities such as these help to build community among neighbors, creating stronger relationships and safer communities. \$2,500-\$5000 depending on the size of the event.

Host a landscape workday to plant bushes and flowers or winterize an area of a residence. A gift of \$5,000 or more will pay for plants and supplies. The Coalition will obtain materials needed and provide the plan and supervision for a 4-hour project.

With other company groups, help furnish new apartment homes for people exiting homelessness into stability.

Provide a grant of \$10,000 or more in support of housing and services, and Coalition staff will work with you to design a volunteer experience for your group or individual volunteers.
