Colorado Coalition for the Homeless' Statement Regarding Unionization Vote of Housing Assistance Department

DENVER, CO - This evening on Wednesday, February 5, staff members from the Housing Assistance Department (HAD) at the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless voted in a National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) supervised election against having the Service Employees International Union (SEIU) represent eligible members of that department on all employment matters. Executive Team members are committed to working collaboratively with the staff who wished to unionize to fully understand and respond to any issues regarding their employment. CCH remains committed to being a safe and fulfilling place of employment while continuing to provide high-quality housing, healthcare, and supportive services to individuals and families experiencing or at risk of homelessness throughout Colorado.
