



At Stout Street Health Center, the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless (CCH) responds to the specialized health needs of adults and children experiencing or at-risk of homelessness. In order to reduce as many barriers as possible for our patients, CCH offers medical and behavioral health care, substance use treatment, dental, vision, and pharmacy services all in one building.

This Community Health Center and its satellite locations prioritize trauma-informed care and patient-centered decision-making in order to fully address the spectrum of health concerns patients bring to their primary care providers. With hundreds of full-time staff members including doctors, nurses, physician assistants, dental staff, optometrists, laboratory personnel, pharmacists, case managers, peer specialists, and additional staff support, our health centers work to provide quality care through evidence-based medicine.

As a Federally Qualified Health Center, Stout Street Health Center meets a stringent set of requirements including an ongoing quality assurance program, comprehensive services for an underserved population, and having leadership from a Consumer Advisory Board

## TRAUMA-INFORMED CARE

Stout Street Health Center uses a trauma-informed care approach to medical care which understands, incorporates, and responds to the trauma of homelessness and extreme poverty. It asks "what has happened to you" as opposed to "what is wrong with you." From how providers interact with patients to the architectural design of the building, trauma-informed care helps the Coalition serve patients in a non-judgmental manner with expertise, kindness, and compassion.
